

AvoGreen® Eyesight Test Requirements

It is a requirement of the Avocado Industry Council Ltd that all Monitors involved in AvoGreen® pest monitoring have adequate eyesight defined as:

- The ability to perceive colour differences and discern fruit markings – the standard test is the Ishihara colour vision test; and
- The ability to sustain focusing over an extended period with clarity of vision; and
- The ability to see fine details at near distances.

The following record is provided to enable the recording of the above requirements.
